






Map of Western Iberia, showing the location of Iron Age sites and the focus of Vettonian Culture with the names of the Celtic tribes according to written sources















Archaeological surveys in the Amblés Valley (1995-2000)







Plan of Ulaca (Collis 2004).








Ulaca cemetery, II-I BC

Landscape management

- Archaeological zone (1994) → all development subject to archaeological control
- Cattle raising allowed
- Hunting is forbidden inside the oppidum



Municipality of Solosancho

- Formed by four villages: Solosancho, Robledillo, Baterna & Villaviciosa
- About 900 inhabitants (2200 in the 50's & 60's)







Luna Celta festival

- Celebrated since 2005 (13 editions)
- 3,000 people inside Ulaca
- Economic return of 150,000 €













Perception study: methodology

• See paper in Landscape Research, 2017 by Moore & Tully

- 1) Semi-structured interviews and focus group (n = 26)
- 2) Perception mapping (n = 20)
- 3) Questionnaires (n = 90):
 - 62% local stakeholders
 - 38% occasional visitors

Defining "cultural landscapes"

- Most of participants were <u>unaware</u> of the term:
 - >57% online survey
 - >65% targeted stakeholders

Defining "oppidum"

- Most of participants in our online survey are <u>aware</u> of the term: 58%
- Although very few of the targeted stakeholders: 27%


