

- Demonstrate value its not just a nice place
  - > Rural business £337m GVA dependent on AONB
  - > Jobs inc 9,720 critically dependent on landscape quality
  - Farming £800m
  - > Tourism 23 million day visits, worth £1bn
  - > Public water supply 500m litres a day to Thames water alone
  - Carbon? Timber? Energy?

- Agree what to aim for




